Breast Pumps are for Breastfeeding

All pumps are not created equal. Some are much more effective than others. Moms do not respond equally to every pump.

Different pumps have different uses. Pumping when there is a medical need or a breastfeeding problem usually requires a different pump than when breastfeeding is going well.

Defining the World of Breast Pumps

Medical Need (aka Hospital Grade)

A pump that is very effective at initiating and maintaining a milk supply. It is often necessary when a mom and her baby must rely on a pump for adequate milk removal (i.e. baby is premature or is having problems latching or removing milk, or a mom has a low milk supply or sore nipples).

Personal Use Pump (aka PUP)

A pump that moms own versus rent. It is used to maintain breastfeeding when a mom is back at work or school or away from her baby short term. It may not be adequate for managing breastfeeding problems. Many moms cannot maintain a good milk supply with a PUP if they are exclusively pumping. HCPCS code = E0603

Closed System

A pump that has a barrier that prevents milk from getting into the pump.

Rental Pump

A pump that is used temporarily, versus being owned. It must have a closed system. For insurance reimbursement, HCPCS code = E0604

- Closed system
- May be effective for Medical Need with some moms
- May require a prescription for insurance coverage

- Personal Use Pump
- May require a prescription for insurance coverage
- Backpack or tote models covered under some plans
