Defining the World of Breast Pumps Medical Need (aka Hospital Grade) Pump: This pump is very effective at initiating & maintaining a milk supply. It is often necessary when a mom & her baby must rely on a pump for adequate milk removal (i.e. baby is premature, baby is having problems latching or removing milk, or a mom has a low milk supply or sore nipples).

Personal Use Pump (aka PUP): This is a pump that a mom owns vs rents. It is used to maintain breastfeeding when a mom is back at work or school or is away from her baby short-term. It may not be adequate for all breastfeeding problems and may not maintain a good supply if a mother is exclusively pumping. Insurance reimbursement HCPCS code = E0603

Closed System: This pump has a barrier that prevents milk from getting into the pump.

Rental Pump: This pump is rented, versus being owned, and must have a closed system. Insurance reimbursement HCPCS code = E0604
